



Information Booth Application

The Morehead Arts & Crafts Festival is on September 17, 2022, on Main Street in downtown Morehead, KY. The event is scheduled from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The fee is \$25 to set up a 10'x10' tent with one 6' table (roughly half of a parallel parking space). For a full parallel parking space, the fee is \$45. You are still limited to one 10'x10' tent but you may add extra tables and displays to your booth.

Exhibitors will be able to start setting up at 8 a.m. and must have all vehicles off the street by 10:30 a.m. Exhibitors may not take booths down until 4 p.m. and are asked to have all spaces cleared and cleaned up by 5 p.m. Exhibitors must bring tents, tables, chairs, etc. to accommodate booth displays. Booth tables must be covered to the ground and all storage containers and boxes hidden from view. Exhibitors are responsible for all garbage pick up in their booth space. You may only hand out information in your booth. Walking down the street with information is prohibited. Use of bull horns, shouting, etc. is prohibited. If you violate any of these rules you will get one warning. If another violation occurs you will be asked to leave the festival. This event is **RAIN OR SHINE!**
